**RESULT DECLARATION (2017-18) AND COMMENCEMENT OF**  
**NEW SESSION (2018-19)**

**Parents are requested to note the following information carefully :-**

1. As the school will be in the process of compiling final results for the current academic session, **the school will remain closed for the students** on the following days :-

- Class IX : **22<sup>nd</sup> Feb to 06<sup>th</sup> March 2018** (Both days inclusive)
- Class XI : **27<sup>th</sup> Feb to 06<sup>th</sup> March 2018** (Both days inclusive)
- Classes KG to VIII : **10<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> March 2018** (Both days inclusive)

2. **Evaluated Answer Sheets to be shown to the students (only) :-**

Students can see their evaluated answer sheets between **0800 to 1145 hrs** as per the schedule given on the school website. Any discrepancy should be brought to the notice of the subject teacher immediately. Representations will not be entertained after the results are declared.

3. **Declaration of Results :-**

Results will be declared on the following dates between **0800 to 1000 hrs**:

- Class IX and XI : **07<sup>th</sup> March 2018**
- Junior School (UKG to V) : **28<sup>th</sup> March 2018**  
(Students to be accompanied by their parents)
- Senior School (VI to VIII) : **28<sup>th</sup> March 2018**
- Class X and XII : To be declared by CBSE in the month of May 2018

**Please Note:**

- (i) Students who are not able to collect their result on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2018, may collect the same on **02<sup>nd</sup> April 2018** between **0930 and 1030 hrs** from Headmistress' Office (Junior School) and Vice Principal's Office (Senior School).
- (ii) **School Dues :- Parents are requested to clear all the outstanding school dues before collecting the Report Cards.**

4. **Text Books and Stationery** - will be available at the school welfare center (Bookshop) from **1000 to 1500 hrs** as per the following schedule :-

**Please Note :**

- (i) The Book Shop will remain open from **0900 to 1400 hrs** on all working days during the academic session.
- (ii) The vendor has been advised to sell only prescribed books and stationery items. You are advised to check and procure only those items that have been authorized/ required.
- (iii) Facility of Book Shop and Uniform Shop is for the convenience of the parents. However, buying from school shop is not mandatory.

5. **School Uniform** :- will be available at the school welfare centre (Uniform Shop) wef **24 March, 2018 between 0900 to 1400 hrs.**

6. **Summer Vacations** :- School will remain closed for Summer Vacation wef **14<sup>th</sup> May to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018.**

7. Please note the dates for the commencement of the new academic session :-

- (a) Class X and XII                   **08 March 2018**
- (b) Classes KG to IX               **02 April 2018**
- (c) Class XI                           **16 April 2018**

8. Kindly abide by the following norms :-

- (a) Your ward should report to school by 0800 hrs in proper school uniform.
- (b) Regularity of attendance is essential, as there is effective teaching in all the classes throughout the session. 75% attendance during the academic year is mandatory for promotion to the next class.
- (c) If a student is absent for six consecutive days without prior written intimation/ permission, his/her name will be struck off from the school Rolls.
- (d) Prior appointment must be obtained for meeting with the Principal, Vice Principal and teaching staff.
- (e) The students are strictly prohibited from carrying mobile phones, smart watches, Holi colours, crackers, sharp objects and any other objectionable items to the school. Please note that the school has no tolerance policy particularly towards mobile phones, cameras and electronic devices. The same would be confiscated by the school authorities.
- (f) The use of internet should be strictly under parental guidance. Kindly dissuade him/ her from joining any social media. Also apprise your child regarding the impending dangers lurking on various social media sites.
- (g) Any objectionable comment/ remark on peer or staff members will incur strict action. Cooperation of parents is solicited in this regard.
